

Audio-Response Question


<u>Note</u>: To use the Recording feature on iOS devices such as iPhones and iPads, make sure your device is updated to iOS/iPadOS 14.3 and your microphone setting in Safari is switched to "allow" mode.

 For Audio-Response questions, you would need to allow the browser to access your microphone to start recording. Click the text box followed by the **Recording** icon at the top left to begin attempting the Audio Response question.



<u>Note</u>: Each recording can be up to a maximum duration of 10 minutes.

<u>Note</u>: Audio recordings can also be downloaded when it is still being processed.

- 7. In an Auto-Graded and a Teacher-Marked Quiz, you can submit after attempting the last question.

Note: You may also see the recommended time and the marks allocated for the question if your teacher has set them.



Uploading Files for Audio Response Questions

For devices that do not support the Recording Feature, click the **Upload** File icon 🔇 where there will be a pop up for you to drag and drop your file from an open folder window or by browsing. The accepted file types and limits are:

- Audio (50MB max): mp3/ogg/webm/mpa/wav/wma/w4a
- Video (500MB max): mp4/mov/m4v/ogv/avi/mpg/mpeg/wmv



Upload File

- 1. Click the **Attach Media** icon **③** and choose the **Upload File** option.
- 2. To upload a file,
 - Drag and drop a file into the box; or
 - Click the box and select a file through the file manager.
- 3. Click Upload when done.

Uploading Media Objects from an iOS Device

- 1. Uploads via iOS devices are supported.
- However, if you encounter any errors, please ensure that you are uploading files from the Photo Library, Take Photo or Video, or Browse from Files.

Uploading Media Objects from an Android Device

- 1. Uploads via Android devices are supported.
- 2. However, if you encounter any errors, please ensure that you are uploading files from the **Phone Directory**.
 - While rare, Android users might encounter problems when uploading files directly from shortcut links such as Picture, Video, and Recent.
